# Hebrews 12:14-15 (NIV)

- [14] Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- [15] See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many.
  - ➤ Luke 7:36-50 Those who love much, forgive much How much you love Jesus will be seen by your forgiveness.

## Matthew 5:20 (NIV)

For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.

#### 1. JESUS SAID, NEVER DO EVIL BACK

## Luke 6:27-28 (NIV)

- [27] "But I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you..."
- [28] "...bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you."

## Romans 12:17-19 (NIV)

- [17] Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody.
- [18] If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
- <sup>[19]</sup> Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.

# 1 Peter 3:9 (NIV)

[9] Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.

## 2 Corinthians 2:10-11 (NIV)

- <sup>[10]</sup> If you forgive anyone, I also forgive him. And what I have forgiven--if there was anything to forgive--I have forgiven in the sight of Christ for your sake...
- [11] ...in order that Satan might not outwit us. For we are not unaware of his schemes.

#### 2. FORGIVENESS IS THE LOVE OF JESUS IN ACTION

# 1. Do not keep a record of wrongs suffered

## 1 Corinthians 13:5 (NIV)

<sup>[5]</sup> It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.

# 2. Do not gossip about a person's sins to others

# Ephesians 4:29 (NIV)

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

# 3. Do not dwell on the offense yourself

# Philippians 4:8 (NIV)

<sup>[8]</sup> Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.

## Matthew 7:1-2 (NIV)

[1] "Do not judge, or you too will be judged."

<sup>[2]</sup> "For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

# Proverbs 24:17-18 (NIV)

[17] Do not gloat when your enemy falls; when he stumbles, do not let your heart rejoice...

[18] ...or the LORD will see and disapprove and turn his wrath away from him.

# Mark 11:25 (NIV)

And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins.

#### 1 Peter 3:8-9 (NIV)

[8] Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.

  [12] Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days...
- [13] ...keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies.

- [16] ...the face of the LORD is against those who do evil, to cut off the memory of them from the earth.
