### Acts 3 – Peter Heals the Lame Man

#### Acts 4:2-3 (NIV)

<sup>[2]</sup> They were greatly disturbed because the apostles were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection of the dead.

<sup>[3]</sup> They seized Peter and John, and because it was evening, they put them in jail until the next day.

#### Acts 4:12 (NIV)

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.

### Sanhedrin Commands Peter Not to Preach

#### Acts 4:17-20 (NIV)

<sup>[17]</sup> "But to stop this thing from spreading any further among the people, we must warn these men to speak no longer to anyone in this name."

<sup>[18]</sup> Then they called them in again and commanded them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus.

<sup>[19]</sup> But Peter and John replied, "Judge for yourselves whether it is right in God's sight to obey you rather than God.

<sup>[20]</sup> For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard."

#### Acts 5:27-29 (NIV)

<sup>[27]</sup> Having brought the apostles, they made them appear before the Sanhedrin to be questioned by the high priest.

<sup>[28]</sup> "We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name," he said. "Yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and are determined to make us guilty of this man's blood."

<sup>[29]</sup> Peter and the other apostles replied: "We must obey God rather than men!"

#### Acts 5:40-41 (NIV)

<sup>[40]</sup> His speech persuaded them. They called the apostles in and had them flogged. Then they ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.

<sup>[41]</sup> The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.
