**THE FIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CHURCH**

**1. "Love God with all your heart"  
WORSHIP**

**Luke 10:38-42 (NIV)**

<sup>[38]</sup> As Jesus and his disciples were on their way, he came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to him.

<sup>[39]</sup> She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet listening to what he said.

<sup>[40]</sup> But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!"

<sup>[41]</sup> "Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things...

<sup>[42]</sup> ...but only one thing is needed. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."

**2. "Love your neighbor as yourself"  
MINISTRY**

**John 13:34 (NIV)**

<sup>[34]</sup> "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."

**1 John 3:16 (NIV)**

<sup>[16]</sup> This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

**3. “Go...make disciples”**  
**EVANGELISM**

**Luke 15:4 (NIV)**

<sup>[4]</sup> "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?"

**4. “Baptizing them”**  
**FELLOWSHIP**

**Matthew 3:16-17 (NIV)**

<sup>[16]</sup> As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him.

<sup>[17]</sup> And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

**5. “Teaching them to do”**  
**DISCIPLESHIP**

**John 14:15 (NIV)**

<sup>[15]</sup> "If you love me, you will obey what I command."

**2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV)**

<sup>[16]</sup> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness...

<sup>[17]</sup> ...so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
