¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:26 (NASB)

²⁶ Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; ..."

Genesis 3:22 (NASB)

²² Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—

Isaiah 6:2-3 (NASB)

² Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

⁸ "... Is there any **God** besides **Me**, Or is there any *other* Rock? I know of none.'"

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY?

Exodus 3:11-14 (NASB)

¹¹ But Moses said to God, "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the sons of Israel out of Egypt?"

¹² And He said, "Certainly I will be with you, and this shall be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall worship God at this mountain."

¹³ Then Moses said to God, "Behold, I am going to the sons of Israel, and I will say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you.' Now they may say to me, 'What is His name?' What shall I say to them?"

¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

Let me tell you how important this doctrine is, if you are wrong on this one...

John 20:28 (NASB)

²⁸ Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

The Doctrine of the Holy Trinity: within the nature of the one God there are three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. These three persons are one God.

Are there really three persons, and if the three persons are ALL called God and if we can demonstrate that there is one God, then we are driven to one possible conclusion.

Things that are equal to each other are equal to the same thing

THE THREE PERSONS ARE THE ONE GOD.

Is Jesus called God

Is the Holy Spirit called God
