**Matthew 25:40**  
**“Now Serving the Least”**

*The king will reply, “Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.”*

**Genesis 37:5-7**  
**“What a Dream”**

[5] *Joseph had a dream, and when he told it to his brothers, they hated him all the more.*

[6] *He said to them, “Listen to this dream I had.*

[7] *We were binding sheaves of grain out in the field when suddenly my sheaf rose and stood upright, while your sheaves gathered around mine and bowed down to it.”*

**1 Samuel 17:38-40**  
**“I Just Gotta Be Me”**

[38] *Then Saul dressed David in his own tunic. He put a coat of armor on him and a bronze helmet on his head.*

[39] *David fastened on his sword over the tunic and tried walking around, because he was not used to them. “I can not go in these,” he said to Saul, “because I am not used to them.” So he took them off.*

[40] *Then he took his staff in his hand, chose 5 smooth stones from the stream, put them in the pouch of his shepherd’s bag and, with his sling in his hand, approached the Philistine.*

**Acts 9:13-16**  
**“God, Are You Kidding Me?”**

[13] *“Lord,” Ananias answered, “I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to your holy people in Jerusalem.*

[14] *And he has come here with authority from the chief priests to arrest all who call on your name."*

[15] *But the Lord said to Ananias, "Go! This man is my chosen instrument to proclaim my name to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel.*

[16] *I will show him how much he must suffer for my name."*

### **Acts 9:17-19**

#### **"God, Are You Kidding Me?"**

[17] *Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord --- Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here --- he has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit."*

[18] *Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized,*

[19] *and after taking some food, he regained his strength.*
