DESIGNER

*People from many nations will come and say,
"Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord...

REVEALER

- Determine to keep the ground level
at the foot of the cross

*Then Peter replied, "I see very clearly
that God shows no favoritism."
Acts 10:34*

- Deem yourself sensitive
to the people around you

*I have become all things to all men
that I may by all means save some.
1Corinthians 9:22*

- Decide ahead of time
to avoid cliques

*Let there be no divisions in the church.
Rather, be of one mind
in thought and purpose.
I Corinthians 1:10*

- Don't have too high
of an estimation of yourself

*Because of the privilege and authority
God has given me, I give each of you this warning:
Don't think you are better than you really are.
Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves,
measuring yourself by the faith God has given us.
Romans 12:3*

- Dedicate yourself to DAILY prayer

*He was a devout, God-fearing man,
as was everyone in his household.
He gave generously to the poor
and prayed regularly to God.
Acts 10:2*

- Develop an expectation
of the Spirit's moving
