- v Two things that serve to block God's comforting words:

FEAR

Psalm 3:5-6

I lay down and slept, yet I woke up in safety; for the Lord was watching over me. I am not afraid of ten thousand enemies who surround me on every side.

FRAILTY

Psalm 28:7-8

The Lord is my strength and shield. I trust him with all my heart. He helps me and my heart is filled with joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving. The Lord gives his people strength.

- v God's love through us produces tangible results when we obey his 'SAY SO'
- v Let God's love run DEEP ENOUGH to affect:

Your HOSPITALITY

Hebrews 13:2

Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without realizing it.

Your EMPATHY

Hebrews 13:3

Remember those in prison; as if you were there yourself. Remember also those being mistreated, as if you felt their pain in your own bodies.

Your FIDELITY

Hebrews 13:4

Give honor to marriage, and remain faithful to one another in marriage. God will surely judge those who are immoral and those who commit adultery.

Your **CONTENTMENT**

Hebrews 13:5

Don't love money; be satisfied with what you have. For God has said, '*I will never fail you. I will never abandon you.*'

Your **AUTHORITY**

Hebrews 13:7

Remember your leaders who taught you the word of God. Think of all the good that has come from their lives, and follow the example of their faith.
