Philippians 2:1-4 (NASB)

^[1] Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is an consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion,

^[2] make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.

^[3] Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

^[4] do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

1 Corinthians 13:4-5 (NASB)

^[4] Love is patient, love is kind *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant,

^[5] does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*.

Philippians 2:5-8 (NASB)

^[5] Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

^[6] who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,

^[7] but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.

^[8] Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
