#### HOW TO RESOLVE CONFLICT

#### Romans 12:17-18 (NIV)

[17] Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody.

[18] If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

# SEVEN STEPS FOR RESOLVING CONFLICT

#### 1. Take the INITIATIVE

#### Matthew 5:23-24 (NIV)

[23] "Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you,

[24] leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.

## Four things you must do in setting up the meeting:

- Ø Choose the RIGHT TIME
- Ø Choose the RIGHT PLACE
- Ø PRAY before the meeting
- Ø Come with a POSITIVE ATTITUDE

## 2. Confess my part in the **CONFLICT**

## **Matthew 7:3-5 (NIV)**

[3] "Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?

[4] How can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?

[5] You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

#### 3. Listen for the HURT

#### James 1:19 (NIV)

My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

#### **Romans 15:2 (NLT)**

We should help others do what is right and build them up in the Lord.

#### 4. Consider their PERSPECTIVE

#### Philippians 2:4-5 (NIV)

[4] Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.

[5] Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus.

#### 5. Tell the truth TACTFULLY

#### Ephesians 4:29 (NIV)

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

You never get your point across by being cross. You are never persuasive when you are abrasive.

#### 6. Fix the **PROBLEM**, not the **BLAME**

#### **Romans 14:13 (NIV)**

Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in your brother's way.

When you belittle someone you are showing how tiny your heart is. Only little people belittle people.

Great people make people feel great.

## 7. Focus on RECONCILIATION, not RESOLUTION

If you learn to disagree without being disagreeable, that's called wisdom.

If you learn that you can have unity without uniformity, that's called wisdom.

If you learn to walk hand in hand without having to see eye to eye, that's called wisdom.

It is always more rewarding to RESOLVE the conflict than to DISSOLVE the relationship.
