**Exodus 3:11-14 (NIV)**

<sup>[11]</sup> But Moses said to God, "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"

<sup>[12]</sup> And God said, "I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain."

<sup>[13]</sup> Moses said to God, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' Then what shall I tell them?"

<sup>[14]</sup> God said to Moses, "**I AM WHO I AM**. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: '**I AM** has sent me to you.'"

**Daniel 2:32-34 (NIV)**

<sup>[32]</sup> The head of the statue was made of pure gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze,

<sup>[33]</sup> its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of baked clay.

<sup>[34]</sup> While you were watching, a rock was cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and smashed them.

**THE SEPTUAGINT:**

The deity of Christ can be seen in His seven "I AMs"

1. **I am** *the bread of life*
2. **I am** *the light of the world*
3. **I am** *the door*
4. **I am** *the good shepherd*
5. **I am** *the resurrection and the life*
6. **I am** *the way, the truth, and the life*
7. **I am** *the true vine*

The Divine title is used “**I AM**”

**John 8:56-59 (NIV)**

<sup>[56]</sup> Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad."

<sup>[57]</sup> "You are not yet fifty years old," the Jews said to him, "and you have seen Abraham!"

<sup>[58]</sup> "I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, **I am!**"

<sup>[59]</sup> At this, they picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus hid himself, slipping away from the temple grounds.

**John 10:27-33 (NIV)**

<sup>[27]</sup> My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

<sup>[28]</sup> I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.

<sup>[29]</sup> My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.

<sup>[30]</sup> **I and the Father are one.**"

<sup>[31]</sup> Again the Jews picked up stones to stone him,

<sup>[32]</sup> but Jesus said to them, "I have shown you many great miracles from the Father. For which of these do you stone me?"

<sup>[33]</sup> "We are not stoning you for any of these," replied the Jews, "but for blasphemy, because you, a mere man, **claim to be God.**"
