**John 6:60-71 [NIV]**

<sup>[60]</sup> On hearing it, many of his disciples said, “This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?”

<sup>[61]</sup> Aware that his disciples were grumbling about this, Jesus said to them, *“Does this offend you?”*

<sup>[62]</sup> *What if you see the Son of Man ascend to where he was before!*

<sup>[63]</sup> *The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life.*

<sup>[64]</sup> *Yet there are some of you who do not believe.”* For Jesus had known from the beginning which of them did not believe and who would betray him.

<sup>[65]</sup> He went on to say, *“This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless the Father has enabled him.”*

<sup>[66]</sup> From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.

<sup>[67]</sup> *“You do not want to leave too, do you?”* Jesus asked the Twelve.

<sup>[68]</sup> Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.

<sup>[69]</sup> We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God.”

<sup>[70]</sup> Then Jesus replied, *“Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil!”*

<sup>[71]</sup> (He meant Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, who, though one of the Twelve, was later to betray him.)
